Verses

Hebrews 10:5 (NLT) That is why, when Christ came into the world, he said to God, "You did not want animal sacrifices or sin offerings. But you have given me a body to offer.

Genesis 3:15 (NLT) And I will cause hostility between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will strike your head, and you will strike his heel.

Devotional

Satan knew the prophecy in Genesis 3:15—that one day a seed would come and crush his head. So from the beginning, Satan tried to stop it. If he could corrupt human DNA through fallen angels and create an unredeemable race, the Messiah couldn't be born. But God preserved the human line, and in time, Jesus was born through the seed of a woman—fully man, fully God. He had to be human to redeem humans.

Reflection
